Duration

Mode of delivery

This internship program will be conducted in a blended mode. (online and in premise of KUSOED)

- Develop a better grasp of education technology and its influence, while also making contributions to research outcomes.
- Opportunity to apply for the paid apprenticeship program within Kathmandu University- School of Education.

Internship candidates must

- Be a student of ongoing degree or graduate program
- Know the general use of computers including but not limited to the internet.
- Adoptive towards varying timeline (if proposed) for internship program

Prior registration is required to enroll in the internship program.

Selection process

Shortlisted candidates will be notified via email for the interview dates.

Method of instructions

The methods of internship will be a combination of varieties of instructional techniques. Including but not limited to :

 3. Session by guest speakers
 4. Practical experiences
 5. Field work
 6. Presentation
